Dear Parish Family,

Most Catholics know that May is the month dedicated to Our Lady, but did you know that the Church dedicates each month to a particular devotion? June is the month dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The origins of this devotion go back to about the middle of the last millennium, but it gained in popularity after Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary of France in the late 17th Century. In short, this devotion is one in which faithful Catholics make reparation for their sins, and the sins of those who are ungrateful for the sacrifice of Christ on the cross. It is also an act of love and trust to the Savior by acknowledging him as the ruler of our hearts, minds, and bodies.

One powerful way by which Catholics can devote themselves more to Christ is to consecrate their homes to his Sacred Heart. So, in the month of June, I have set aside time to come to the homes of the faithful to carry out this holy rite. Simply call or email the office to schedule a time. The rite requires an image of the Sacred Heart, a prominent place to display the image with a white cloth, and candles to burn during the ritual. If you lack an image, or candles, the parish will provide. The rite takes about 20 minutes.

The month of June has unfortunately become a month that celebrates a mockery of God's love in the secular culture. It is for this reason Catholics must more devote themselves to the loving Sacred Heart of Christ, and to place their trust in him. Please do make an appointment for this powerful devotion as a means of renewing the Church in Charity and Truth.
