READ TODAY'S DAILY READING HERE

Dear Parish Family,

This weekend our republic celebrates fathers. No doubt many of you will celebrate with your own children, and your own fathers. I myself will be heading up to Mt. Pleasant where all the kids and grandkids will gather at my parents' place. These are happy occasions indeed.

Nevertheless, many of you might struggle this day. It is no secret that many individuals suffer from wounds of the father for various reasons: abandonment, abuse, early death, etc. These wounds can particularly hinder one's growth in the faith as we call God "Our Father," and the priests of his Church "Father." These hindrances are quite understandable. The good news, however, is that Our Father in Heaven desires to heal us of such wounds, and no wound is too deep or too painful for him to overcome. In this limited space I wish to point you to one particular means of healing: St. Joseph.

Joseph is the adoptive father of Jesus, and thus he has a special place in his heart for those who need a father here on earth. From my own experience as a spiritual counselor, I can say with confidence that those who develop a relationship with Joseph find themselves more and more able to accept the love of God the Father and admire fatherhood in general.

The best place to start is to just tell St. Joseph what is on your heart and ask him to help you with his prayers. This silent saint will deliver, and the happy occasion of Father's Day is a good time to start.
