Dear Parish Family,

The month of September is particularly devoted to Mary, the Sorrowful Mother, also known as Our Lady of Sorrows, Our Lady of Compassion, or the Seven Sorrows of Mary. The devotion to Our Lady of Sorrows has many spiritual fruits, but it is mostly known for helping individuals come to understand how there is redemption in suffering. The sufferings of Christ and the Blessed Mother brought about the redemption of mankind. While it was Christ alone who redeemed us by his sacrifice, his Holy Mother suffered greatly for our sins during his Passion. This means that we have a powerful intercessor who understands our own sorrows, and who knows better than any other saint how such suffering brings about greater joy in light of eternity. It also helps us be kind, and hospitable to our suffering neighbors. As one former student of mine puts it, "The Seven Sorrows turns ugly crying into beautiful crying."

There is always great suffering in our world, and in our homes. There will be until Christ restores all things to himself. The positive news is that we can find the goodness, joy, and growth amidst all tragedy as Mary did amidst hers.

Below is a brief devotion to the Seven Sorrows of Mary.

**Opening Prayer:** Our Father

Offer one Hail Mary after briefly recalling each sorrow.

1. The Prophecy of Simeon
2. The Flight to Egypt
3. The Loss of the Child Jesus
4. Mary Meets Jesus as he Carries the Cross
5. The Crucifixion of Jesus
6. Jesus is Taken from the Cross
7. Jesus is Laid in the Tomb

Lord God, our Father, from the passion and death of Jesus, shared by the compassion of His mother, you brought healing to fallen man.
