Dear Parish Family,

“Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me; and whoever receives me, receives not me but the One who sent me.” (Mark Ch. 9) When the faithful receive the gift of children we are really receiving the gift of Christ himself. But what does it mean to receive a child? Among all the joys are also all the responsibilities: feeding, clothing, sheltering, bathing, and rearing. For the Christian parents it also means teaching their children the faith of Jesus Christ. This is more than simply dropping a child off for religious education once a week a handful of times a year and calling it good. The faith is more caught than taught, and so parents must set an example of prayerfulness, virtue, and repentance in the home as a foundation for the "book learning" of the faith.

At the end of my life Christ will judge how well I fulfilled my responsibilities as a priest. At the end of the lives of Christian parents that same Christ will judge how well they fulfilled their roles to raise their children in the faith. It is my responsibility to provide a strong Catholic education at this parish for our children, but it is the responsibility of the parents to partake in that education.

I am quite pleased with what the staff and I have put together to educate our children in the faith of Jesus Christ. Parents and students will meet every first Sunday of the month at 10am for an hour of instruction. The parents will be given the tools to teach their children lessons in the faith at home, and we will send out regular web-based help. This helps us sanctify the Lord's Day even more and gives parents the flexibility to teach the faith in the home on their own time.

I pray I will be quite pleased with the response of our parish parents as well. So, sign up your children for religious education, and give them the gift of eternal life.
