Dear Parish Family,

This past Monday Holy Mother Church celebrated the memorial of St. Andrew Kim and Companions. These saints are also known as The Martyrs of Korea, and their story is a fairly unique one in the history of the faith. 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> Century Korea completely shut itself off to the outside world. No influences from beyond its borders were legal, including Christianity. Nevertheless, books about the faith, including Scripture found their way into the country. Some Koreans found these books and began to baptize one another and lead each other in devotions. Academic study of Jesus Christ also took place as best as they could manage. When missionaries found their way to Korea, they were shocked to discover that there was this fruitful, underground Church comprised of only lay faithful. These lay faithful were overjoyed that they finally met the priests they had read about and were able to receive the sacraments they so desired amidst government persecution. Among these lay faithful was St. Andrew Kim who became the first known priest ordained on the Korean Peninsula.

The 100+ martyrs of 19<sup>th</sup> Century Korea, and their predecessors are a shining example of doing what we can with what we have where we are. These Christians had so little, including clergy, but they remained as faithful as they could with what they could find about Jesus Christ. This is not to underplay the importance of the ordained, but rather the strength that comes when lay Catholics place prayer and study over that of activism. The Lord blessed them with strong faith, and in time with clergy. Today the Church of South Korea is growing and growing quickly. A country without priests is now ordaining young men to the priesthood in amazing numbers. May the Korean Church remind us of just how powerful daily, and humble devotion can be.
