Ultimately, they all refer to the gift Jesus gave us in coming with a contrite heart to say our sins out loud to a priest who is acting in persona Christi - or in the place of Christ. In John 20:23, Jesus gives our priests authority to then forgive our sins, which happens through absolution. Finally, we do penance, or small acts of love - often in prayer or service - at the direction of the priest to make up for those sins, and we go out to do our best in the world trying not to sin again. ~Mrs. Stephanie Smith
