It is good to be home, and good to be writing bulletin articles again. I pray you are all enjoying a restful Labor Day weekend that will lead into a wonderful Michigan Fall. I, for one, am looking forward to the return of the crisp Autumn air.

The month of September is dedicated to the Seven Sorrows of Mary. Our Blessed Mother is considered to be a martyr not in blood, but in heart and soul as she suffered by witnessing the injustices inflicted upon her son, Jesus. Meditating on the Seven Sorrows was a devotion that emerged in the 14th Century after Holy Mary appeared to St. Brigid of Sweden.

A quick Googling will bring up the full Chaplet of the Seven Sorrow, and how to even purchase one (similar to a rosary). However, one can also simply meditate on each of the sorrows with a single Hail Mary. Below I have listed the sorrows, and I invite you to join me in praying over them this month.
