St. Martin's will have a Front Porch Spring Bake Sale on June 11th! Bring your best treats and take home someone else's!

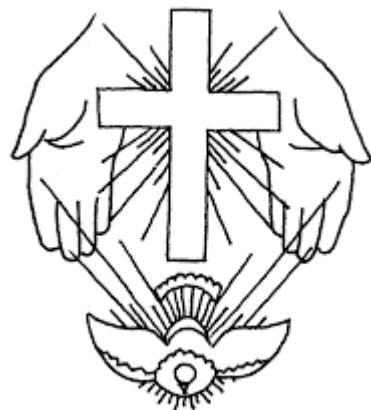
Dear Parish Family,
