Dear Parish Family,

"Because even when it is celebrated on the humble altar of a country church, the Eucharist is always in some way celebrated on the altar of the world. It unites heaven and earth. It embraces and permeates all creation." — St. John Paul II, Ecclesia de Eucharistia, April 17, 2003.

I came across this quote again this week as I was making preparations for our upcoming Corpus Christi Procession (June 2). Sometimes they just need to come to the church for private prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. If you let me know ahead of time, I'll make sure the doors are unlocked at either location within reason.
