Dear Parish Family,

As you know, every year there is an appeal from the headquarters of the Diocese of Saginaw. In short, this appeal is a tax on the parish to fund the diocesan level of the Church. Funds from the appeal go towards many operations that the parish level cannot afford or manage on its own. I will soon write a letter to all parishioners about some of these operations in particular. For now, however, I want to share some good news about this year's appeal. While we were originally assessed to contribute roughly \$33K, Bishop Gruss has reduced our assessment to just under \$29.5K. He has made proportional reductions for many parishes in these 11 counties. He has made these reductions in light of the economic struggles many of the faithful, and parishes as a whole are facing.

Additionally, we are doing better at this time of year than we were last year in hitting our target. We hit that target last year, and I am thankful.

Our bishop has granted us reduced assessment this year. Let us show him, and the diocesan church, our thankfulness and be generous towards this effort. I can assure you that the diocesan offices do help us at the parish on a regular basis.
